Best known for his Latin-tinged soul-jazz group 'Working Week', which recorded extensively and played major European jazz festivals during the 1980s, mixing jazz with vocals from the likes of Juliet Roberts, Robert Wyatt, Julie Tippett and Tracy Thorn. He's also worked with Keith Tippett, Louis Moholo, Tony Oxley, Peter Brotzmann, Trevor Watts' 'Moire Music' and played for several years in the London Jazz Composers Orchestra. He currently works in a quartet with pianist Howard Riley and his own trio Game Theory, recently described by BBC's Jazz on 3 as 'free jazz techno funk': with RALPH FREEMAN TRIO £6/£4

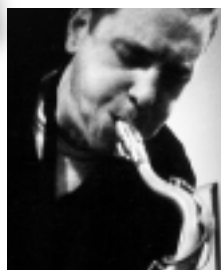
